## Can I enter by post?

Yes if you have a friend without internet access, print off the submission form and ask them to send it to: Kitchen Table, Hain Frozen Foods UK Ltd, Holt Road, Fakenham, Norfolk, NR21 8EH

## Does my dish have to be totally original?

Yes, but it can be a variation on a classic. Or you might have an idea that's a take on one of our existing dishes?. Remember, it's all about having fun, so let yourself go!

## If my dish doesn't win, might you still want to add it to the range?

Yes, we might well add more than one new dish to the range. We'll of course contact you first though. We have a constant development process at Linda McCartney so your idea or something very similar could already be in development.

## What if someone sends in the same dish as me?

It will simply be a case of whoever's dish was submitted first.
